

Proceeding from the international recognition of national identities of the Republic of Serbia and the Republic of Montenegro, status of the Republic of Serbia as a successor of the Serbia and Montenegro state union, that is Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, and from the necessity to arrange relations in area of managing domain and subdomain names system on the Internet,

Register of the national Internet domain of the Republic of Serbia, subject entitled to manage the domain register of the Republic of Serbia (hereinafter: **RNDIS**)

and

Center of Information Technology at the University of Montenegro, subject entitled to manage the domain register of the Republic of Montenegro (hereinafter: **CIS**),

enclose:

A G R E E M E N T
on transition of domain and subdomain name
registered under YU domain into RS and ME domains

I – DEFINITION OF TERMS

Article 1

ccTLD Country Code Top Level Domain within the hierarchy of global domains system,

assigned according to the two-letter codes in ISO 3166-1 standard codes;

YU domain ccTLD of the former Yugoslavia;

RS domain ccTLD of the Republic of Serbia;

ME domain ccTLD of the Republic of Montenegro;

II – GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 2

The subject of this Agreement is regulation of matters regarding transition and use of domain and subdomain names registered under the YU domain into new RS and ME domains, as well as regulation of relations between subjects in the Republic of Serbia and Republic of Montenegro entitled to manage registrars ccTLD .RS and .ME respectfully, during the period of transition.

Article 3

Due to the fact that one of the basic rights is the right on Internet domain use as well as realising this right according to the completely equal principles, parties have agreed that all

registered domain and subdomain names under the YU domain must be available for use according to this Agreement and in time period determined by this Agreement.

Article 4

Managing and use of registered domain and subdomain names under the YU domain, as well as their transition into new RS and ME domains, implies high level of responsibility and respect of interests of all interested parties.

III – TRANSITION PRESUMPTIONS

Article 5

Subjects entitled to manage registers of RS and ME domains, in analysis performed with the subject

entitled for managing the YU domain register, have specified that registered domains could be classified as follows:

a) Registered domain and subdomain names under:

- **CG.YU** – domain delegated to T-Com in Montenegro,
- **MN.YU** – state administration bodies of the Republic of Montenegro whose registration was delegated to the Secretariat for Development of the Republic of Montenegro,
- **CG.AC.YU** – Academic institutions in the Republic of Montenegro whose registration was delegated to the Information Technology Center of the University of Montenegro,

b) All other domain and subdomain names.

Domain users a), during the process of transition, should address the subject entitled to administer the .ME register, according to the regulations on registration and transition of this organisation's domain.

Domain users b), during the process of transition, should address the subject entitled to administer the .RS register, according to the regulations on registration and transition of this organisation's domain.

Article 6

Subjects entitled to administer RS and ME registers have agreed that the register entitled to administer the RS domain should take over the administration of the YU domain and managing the process of transition, in accordance with this Agreement.

IV – DURATION OF TRANSITION

Article 7

Through special regulations, each party will establish the procedure and final terms for transition of domains under Article 5.

During the transition process all domain and subdomain name owners, under the YU domain, are obliged to file a Request for pre-registration to the subjects entitled for administration of .RS and .ME registers, in accordance with Article 5 of this Agreement. This should be done within the specified timeframe and according to the regulations on domain name registration adopted by the relevant registers.

Article 8

The subject entitled for the administration of the RS domain, who will take over the administration of the YU domain, is obliged to secure that subdomains listed under Article 5, Section a) will remain delegated to organisations in Montenegro listed under this section until the definite termination of the YU domain.

All data changes in the register that are related to domains listed under Article 5, Section a) will be recorded into the register of YU domains exclusively upon the requests received from the organisation delegated to register this subdomain name, and under the same terms that will be applied for other domain names in the YU register.

All other domains - Article 5, Section b) are under the full authority of subjects entitled to administer RS domains.

Article 9

Subjects entitled to administer RS and ME registers are obliged to inform domain and subdomain name users under the YU domain, in public and via Internet, about all relevant matters regarding transition from this Agreement and about specific regulations of each subject entitled to administer .RS and .ME registers.

VI - TRANSITIONAL AND FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 10

This Agreement comes into effect on the day of the signing.

Article 11

This Agreement is drawn up in 4 identical copies, where each party retains two copies.
